### ACCEPTED ITEMS

#### NEWSPAPER

Inserts can be included. **NO:** plastic bags, string, twine, stickers, coins or plastic stuck on papers

#### GLOSSY MAGAZINES & CATALOGS

Must be glossy on all pages. May be staple or glue bound. Remove from plastic or paper bags. Remove all string or twine. **NO:** junk mail, phone books, TV Guides or books

#### TIN CANS & ALUMINUM

Rinse clean and flatten. **NO:** plastic bags, paint cans, appliances, hangers, fencing, scrap metal, aerosol cans or containers with food residue

#### CORRUGATED CARDBOARD & BROWN PAPER BAGS

Break down boxes and remove any contaminants (Styrofoam, wood or food). **NO:** plastic bags, wax-coated boxes, 6-, 12- or 24-pack beverage cases

#### CLEAR & COLORED GLASS

Container glass, food and beverage bottles in clear, brown and shades of blue and green are accepted. Rinse clean and remove lids. **NO:** plastic bags, CRT glass (monitors or TV screens), light bulbs, window glass, mirrors, drinking glasses, cups, bowls or plates

#### BOXBOARD

Break down boxes and remove any packaging inside boxes. **NO:** plastic bags; cardboard; boxes containing plastics; liquids or food residue; 6-, 12- or 24-pack beverage cases; Styrofoam; wax-coated boxes; freezer or refrigerator food boxes; boxes with foil lamination or canisters

#### #2 HDPE MILK JUGS

Remove and discard lids, rinse clean and flatten. Containers must have a seam and the #2 HDPE symbol on bottom. **NO:** motor oil bottles; Styrofoam; clear #1, #3 or #6 plastic; HDPE #2 colored plastic jugs or tubs (cottage cheese, sour cream, margarine)

#### MIXED PLASTIC BOTTLES & TUBS

Containers with #1 through #7 symbols on bottom accepted, including bottles and jugs with narrow, threaded neck; plastic tubs (margarine, sour cream, cottage cheese, etc.); microwave trays; and yogurt containers. **NO:** plastic bags, paper wax-coated milk or juice cartons, Styrofoam containers/packaging, syringes, garden hose/rubber, furniture, pools, toys, or free flowing liquids

#### TEXTILES

Accepted items include clothing such as jackets, coats, sweaters, pants, children's clothes, undergarments, athletic gear, bathing suits, hats, gloves and socks. Nonclothing items such as laptop covers, small luggage, bags, wallets, accessories and jewelry are also accepted. Accepted household items include soft toys, stuffed animals, blankets, sheets, towels, shower curtains, comforters, drapery, mats and small rugs. Items in any condition (damaged, missing buttons or zippers, dirty or stained) are accepted. **NO:** Items too large to fit into the container, mattresses, furniture, appliances, electronics or trash

#### OFFICE PAPER

Office paper is collected at the Recycling Center building Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.
